What is an ATM card? An ATM card is a small, pocket size, plastic card that gives you access to the money you have in your savings account. You can use an ATM card at an ATM machine. What is an ATM machine you may ask? An ATM machine is an automated teller machine. You can insert your ATM card into the card reader slot on an ATM and enter your assigned PIN number to process a financial transaction.

Lets take it back one step, when you have an ATM card, you are issued a PIN number. This is a top secret number! You should never share your assigned PIN number with anyone other than your parents.

Why do I need an ATM card? An ATM card comes in handy because it gives you access to your money 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Even during times when your Credit Union is closed. ATM machines never close. Stop by to see a member services representative, and order your new ATM card next time you visit Heart O' Texas FCU.

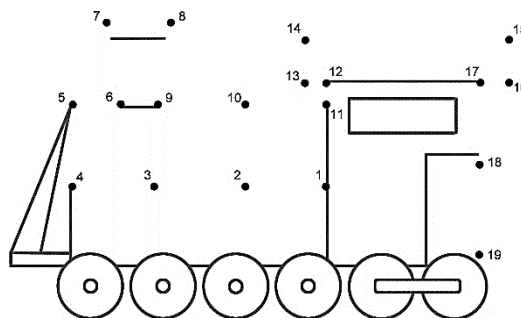
